Among the speakers at Nancy Reagan's April 24 First Ladies Conference on **Drug** Abuse at the White House will be a 17-year-old high school junior from Cincinnati. Mrs. Reagan met Robin [REDACTED] last fall when she visited a **drug** rehabilitation center run by the **Straight** program.

"Mrs. Reagan was so taken with Robin that she asked Robin to accompany her to her next stop in Indianapolis," says Betsy Koons, the first lady's assistant press secretary.

A graduate of **Straight's** Cincinnati program, [REDACTED] will deliver the "personal" side of **drug** abuse at the conference's morning session. Covering the national picture will be presidential assistant Carlton Turner and the international view will come from assistant secretary of state Jon Thomas. In the afternoon session, the focus will be on grass-roots efforts by parent and private sector groups to combat youthful **drug** abuse.
