

Man sues drug-rehabilitation facility

A Hamilton man is seeking \$1 million in damages from Straight, Inc., the Clermont County drug-rehabilitation facility, for emotional damages he said he suffered several years ago.

In a suit filed this week in Clermont County Common Pleas Court, Kenneth [REDACTED] maintained that he was denied sufficient food

and sleep during his stay at Straight, in Mulberry, from Oct. 8, 1984, to May 21, 1985.

He said he was subjected to painful physical restraint in an isolation room, and as a result suffered from nervousness, anxiety and depression.

Straight officials could not be reached for comment.
