

Judge Returns Girl To 'Straight' Program

Hamilton County Juvenile Judge John O'Connor Monday ordered Lisa Ann [REDACTED] 16, back to the Straight Inc. drug rehabilitation program in Milford.

[REDACTED] who was released mistakenly from custody following a court hearing Friday, turned herself in late Saturday.

The Friday court hearing was to determine where [REDACTED] should be placed because she ran from a Straight Inc. foster home in Wyoming. She had been placed in the foster home because of her progress at Straight's Milford operation.

[REDACTED] was apprehended a few

days after running away and court officials Friday ordered her return to Straight Inc.

Officials at the juvenile detention center, however, mistakenly released her.

Monday, O'Connor said, [REDACTED] appeared "scared and afraid." He ordered [REDACTED] back to Straight Inc. because of the organization's success in drug therapy. "That's their reason for being," O'Connor said.

He said that as [REDACTED] hugged representatives from Straight Inc. as she left the courtroom and said she was glad to be back in the program.
