

## Drug Program Moves Today Into Tristate

A SUCCESSFUL youth drug rehabilitation program moves into the Cincinnati area today . . . and 52 area youths who have been taking part in the program in St. Petersburg, Fla..

The program is called STRAIGHT INC. It opens a branch operation today at 6072 Branch Hill-Guinea Road, off Ohio 28 in Clermont County. Dozens of Tristate families whose children have experienced drug problems have sent them to Florida to take part in the program. These youngsters now will be able to undergo rehabilitation closer to home.

Local enthusiasm for the program resulted in authorization of the Clermont

branch.

The program started a couple of years ago in St. Petersburg and later opened branches in Sarasota, Fla. and Atlanta, Ga.
