RULES FOR PARENT WEEKEND

- 1. HONESTY.
- What you see here, what you hear here, what you do here, remains here.
- No guy-girl relationships. (Expressions of love between mother-son or father-daughter, including phasers, are not considered to be guy-girl relationships.)
- 4. No borrowing money.
- 5. Everyone must wear shoes and stockings.
- 6. No parent-newcomers talking to parent-newcomers.
- No breaking anyone's anonymity.
- No talking behind anyone's back.
- Follow the Chain-of-Command newcomer to oldcomer to fifth phaser to Parent Staff to Professional Staff.
- 10. No cameras or tape recorders.
- 11. No listening to the radio or watching TV.
- 12. No wearing of jewelry of any kind wedding rings are OK.
- 13. No making or receiving telephone calls or letters.
- All medications must be turned in to Staff upon arrival at the building.
- No taking of any medication at home or in route without prior Staff permission.
- 16. Don't be late.
- 17. No stopping anywhere on the way to or from Parent Weekend. You may pickup and return your phasers to the Building.
- 18. No talking in the bathrooms or in the parking lot.
- 19. No overalls or white or "concert" type tee shirts no dresses.
- 20. No cosmetics no makeup.
