- 1. HONESTY
- 2. What you see here, what you hear here, what you do here remains here.
- 3. No dating on your phases and for six months thereafter.
- 4. Guys wear shirts, girls wear bras, and everyone must wear shoes and socks.
- 5. No hitchhiking or picking up hitchhikers.
- 6. No borrowing money, candy or cigarettes.
- 7. No newcomers talking to newcomers.
- 8. No druggie friends or druggie hangouts.
- 9. Dime Therapy get three (3) 4th Phase phone numbers. It is the kids' responsibility to get the phone numbers before going home on 2nd Phase. Also, two 5th Phase numbers, a Staff Trainee number and a Junior Staff number.
- 10. No breaking anyone's anonymity or talking behind anyone's back.
- 11. Permissions must be o.k.'d first by parents, then by staff and requested at least 72 hours in advance.
- 12. Follow Chain of Command.
- 13. Report all stashes (drugs or stolen articles or paraphernalia).
- 14. Report anyone who you think may cop out to staff.
- 15. No cameras, tape recorders, or radios in the building.
- 16. Check out drop-offs.
- 17. No wearing jewelry or makeup on any phase.
- 18. No making or receiving phone calls or letters on Phases 1, 2 or 3.
- 19. Report any suspicious-looking character on the grounds.
- 20. All medication must be checked out by Staff.
- 21. No telling your parents your host parents' name or phone number.
- 22. If you are late, you make up a day. If your newcomer is late, you make up a day for him/her.
- 23. No stopping anywhere going to or from Straight.
- 24. If you get sick, report it to staff.
- 25. No talking in bathrooms.

- 27. No overalls or white "T"-shirts.
- 28. No radio, TV or reading on 1st and 2nd phase, except for the Bible on 2nd Phase.
- 29. No talking out in group.
- 30. No coing outside on 1st or 2nd Phase.
- 31. No hanging out in the parking lot.
- 32. No going to sleep with the radio on or TV on.
- 33. No Saturday Night Live or drug related music.
- 34. Pick up all trash around your seat.
- 35. No leaning or slouching.
- 36. No getting out of your seat without permission.
- 37. Knock on all doors before entering.
- 38. Hang on tight to newcomers by the belt loop.
- 39. Sign in and Sign out.
- 40. What you hear in Staff Office stays in Staff Office.
- 41. No asking questions of 5th Phasers or Staff during raps.
- 42. No newcomers wear belts.
- 43. Go over newcomers' MI's at night.
- 44. No playing off.
- 45. No lifting weights until 3rd Phase.
- 46. No crew cuts.

## OPEN METING RULES

- 1. No passing anything during Open Meeting.
- 2. No eye games during Open Meeting.
- 3. No writing of anything during Open Meeting.
- 4. Stand up when parents stand up.
- 5. No talking out to parents -- except for saying "I love you".
- 6. No slang or profanity on introduction
- 7. Honesty on Introduction
- 8. Report all suspicious looking characters during Open Meeting
- 9. Open Meeting Introductions: Name, age, drugs, how long on drugs, how long here past, present, future.

- 10. No cameras, tape recorders, or radios in Group during Open Meeting.
- 11. No asking parents for wants and needs during "Talk".
- 12. No faking out parents with privileges earned.
- 13. No asking 5th phasers questions during Open Meeting.
- 14. If you are an oldcomer and have a younger brother or sister who earns talk, you do not sit in on the talks.
