GENERAL

CONSEQUENCES

1. No Swearing !!!
- 1st time warning 2nd ~~no deserts~~ no deserts for 2 days
2. Mom & Dad have final say. No "Playing Off".
- 1st warning 2^o time Report to staff
3. M.I.s will be done before any other activities. Once home; no more than 1 hour spent on writing and reviewing M.I.s. You will then pick out clothes for next day and then snack time.
- Immediately reporting to staff
If failed to do M.I. If time is not met request extension permission by parents.
4. Upon entering the house; shoes and/or boots will be removed at front door.
- Vacuum the steps + wash (prop) the foyer.
5. No using telephone without parents permission. Parents will supervise all calls. Dime Therapy and Friendship calls will be limited to ten minutes.
- Loss of friendship privilege for a time period determined by Mom + Dad.
6. Doors and windows are to never be opened without permission.
- Reported to Staff
7. Leaving time in the morning; you must be in the car by time specified.
- First time warning, 2^o time Loss of ~~snack~~ of desert, 3^o Report to Staff
8. Permission must be asked before watching T.V. or listening to stereo or radio. Parents will decide which programs you may watch or listen and the volume.
- Loss of privilege at a time determined by parents
9. Homework or work will take priority over all other leisure time activities.
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10. All permissions will be given to parents for approval the night before.
- Permission not submitted
11. Permission must be granted by parents for all food and/or drinks. Except water.
- Loss of ~~snack~~ / deserts.
12. You must have a "to do" list written the night before a day off and reviewed with Mom or Dad.
- Spend day off in building
13. Parents have the right to open and read all mail whether incoming or outgoing.
- loss letter writing privilege
- incoming letter held for one w
14. ALL friendships will be approved by parents.
- loss of privilege to have friendship + reported to staff
15. A Rules Rap will be held once a month. Oldcomers are responsible for newcomers knowing and understand the rules.
- Oldcomer does consequences for rule violation

16. Lights will be turned off when not in the room. - To perform chore as determined by Mom + DAD.
17. There will be at least two family activities a month and everyone must participate. (Policy)
18. Oldcomers are responsible for all locks and keys. - Irresponsibility reported to staff
19. Fifth phase activities on days off will be according to Mom & Dad's priorities. - (Policy)
20. Mom and Dad's bedroom is off limits. - (Policy)
21. Food is to be eaten in designated areas. No food in bathrooms, bedrooms or living room. - Consequences as determined by Mom + DAD
22. Showers are limited to four (4) minutes. Newcomers shower at night and oldcomers in the morning. Shower (tub) will be wiped clean after each use. - Will do the clean up task for 2 days in a row
23. Beds must be made and clothes put away daily. Dirty clothes must be in clothes hamper or they will not be washed. - Make every body's bed for 2 days.
24. Parents have the right to enter bedroom and closets at any time. - (Policy)
25. Clean up after yourself in the kitchen. Rinse dishes, wipe table, wipe counter and push chair up to table. - Consequences as determined by Mom + DAD
26. Do not operate microwave without Mom or Dad's permission. Also applies to stove. - Loss of use.
27. Phasers will eat breakfast only after being dressed and ready to leave home. -
28. Mom and Dad have final say in all matters. If you have a problem with anything; use our home chain-of-command which is to talk to your oldcomer (if any) and if not resolved, talk to Mom or Dad. - Policy
29. Household chores such as moping floors, dusting, vacuuming, washing clothes, washing dishes, sweeping garage, mowing lawn, etc.; are expected to be done on Wednesday night and Sunday morning as well as any time in between as needed and without being asked over and over. - Policy
30. No borrowing of personal items without Mom or Dad's permission. - Policy

7. Doors and windows are 'never' to be opened without Parents permission.	A. Reported to Staff IMMEDIATELY!!!!!!
8. Leaving time in the morning; you must be in the car at the time specified.	A. Consequence list.
9. Permission must be asked before watching TV or listening to stereo or radio. Parents will decide which programs you may watch or listen to and the volume.	A. Loss of priveledge for time specified by Parents.
10. Homework or work will take priority over all other leisure time activities.	A. Consequence list.
11. All permissions will be given to Parents for approval the night before.	A. Permission refused
12. Permission must be granted by Parents for all food and/or drinks 'Except water'.	A. Consequence list.
13. You must have a 'to do' list written the night before a day off and reviewed with Mom or Dad.	A. Day at the Building.
14. Parents have the right to open and read all mail whether incoming or outgoing.	A. Loss of priveledge for time spcified by Parents.
15. All friendships will be approved by Parents.	A. Loss of priveledge.

28. Clean up after yourself in the kitchen. Rinse dishes, wipe tables, wipe counter and push chair up to table after eating.	A. Consequence list.
29. Refill ice cube trays after using.	A. Clean refrigerator.
30. Mom and Dad have final say in all matters. If you have a problem with 'anything': use our home 'chain-of-command' which is to talk to your Oldcomer(if any) and if not resolved, talk to Mom or Dad.	POLICY
31. Chores are to be done without being told over and over.	A. Consequence list + same chore completed.
32. No borrowing of personal items without Mom or Dad giving permission first.	POLICY
33. Late being in bed without Mom and Dad's expressed permission	A. Consequence list.

12. BE IN ROOM BY 11:30 T-W-TH, 12:30 SUN & ASAP M & F (1½ HR MAXIMUM)
13. AN EXTRA 30 MINUTES MAY BE ALLOWED AT NIGHT AT PARENTS' DESCRETION
(ASK IN ADVANCE)
14. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING YOURSELF UP EVERYDAY BY 10:00 SUNDAYS
15. BREAKFAST: 6:30 WEEKDAYS 8:45 SATURDAYS 11:30 SUNDAYS
16. DEPARTURE TIMES: 8:25 WEEKDAYS 9:25 SATURDAYS 1:25 SUNDAYS
17. PERMISSIONS: FILLED OUT AT NIGHT NO LAST MINUTE RUSH JOBS!!
18. DO JOBS AS ASSIGNED ON WEDNESDAYS AND SUNDAYS
19. COOK(S) DO NOT CLEAN UP ON SUNDAYS
20. MOM'S, DAD'S, AMY'S & LIVING ROOMS OFF LIMITS WITHOUT PERMISSION
21. DIME THERAPY ENCOURAGED 10 MINUTE LIMIT UNLESS EMERGENCY
22. PERMISSION CALLS LIMITED TO 20 MINUTES
