STASHES

Articles brought to the program as evidence of drug usage or drug-related activities, theft, or other incriminating behavior that could harm the child, will be disposed of by turning narcotics, paraphrenalia, stolen articles, etc. over to the Police Department. None of these items will be returned to the family.

NON-STASH

Any items brought in as "old ties" will not be returned to the child. Something of value (jewelry, car, motorcycles, etc.) will be turned over to the parents. They will be asked to deal with these items as they wish. It should be emphasized that the client is giving up these items as part of his past.

ARTICLES OF CLOTHING

We have asked that new or valuable clothes not be sent to the children. All articles must be labeled with complete last name. We cannot be responsible for lost clothing, shoes, or other items left in a temporary home. The client should make an effort to see that his/her belongings are kept with them, as we do not accept responsibility for lost articles.

REFRESHER

Items such as pocketbooks, wallets, jewelry, etc. will be returned to the parents in the case of a Refresher. Staff who searches child will be responsible for these items getting back to the family.
