

Four final, and important, points:

- We give the Commissioners photocopies of your response, so you should submit *legible* documents and,
 - avoid using double sided copies and,
 - with the exception of those pages separating the various sections, avoid using colored paper, as they do not duplicate well.
- In preparing your response be certain to avoid the use of any references that will reveal your organization's identity. All descriptive markers must be erased or blacked out. These include the organization's name, program, logos, letterheads, and the last names of all personnel and board members. Also, the city, county, state, zip code, area code, and any other word or image that will prevent the organization from remaining anonymous must be concealed. **Your failure to redact some or all-identifying information will be deemed as a waiver of your right to confidentiality;** and,
- Please do not redact your organization's ID#, as it is the only means for COA to identify your organization's report at the Commission meeting.
- The Commission meets on a bi-monthly basis, and once your response is reviewed, a final decision is rendered and COA will send you a preliminary notification letter within seven (7) business days.
