CLIENT WITHDRAWAL RULE

Court-ordered clients may not withdraw voluntarily. This rules applies only to voluntary clients.

"As a voluntary client I understand that I have the right to withdraw from the program at any time by informing the appropriate staff member of my decision.

If I am under 18 years of age and wish to withdraw, I can send a chain-of-command through a Fifth Phaser to Staff informing them of my decision. I understand that I will be asked to take some time to avoid an impulsive decision. I can expect One-to-Ones with Fifth Phasers and/or Staff and a Family Conference. If after the One-to-Ones and Family Conference I still wish to leave, I will be released to my parents with their consent. If they do not wish to take me, the State Agency will be notified.

If I am 18 years of age or over and wish to withdraw, I can send a chain-of-command through a Fifth Phaser to Staff informing them of my decision. I understand that I will be asked to take some time so as to avoid an impulsive decision. I can expect One-to-Ones with Fifth Phasers and/or Staff and a Family Conference during the process. If after the One-to-Ones and Family Conference I still wish to leave, then I will leave."
