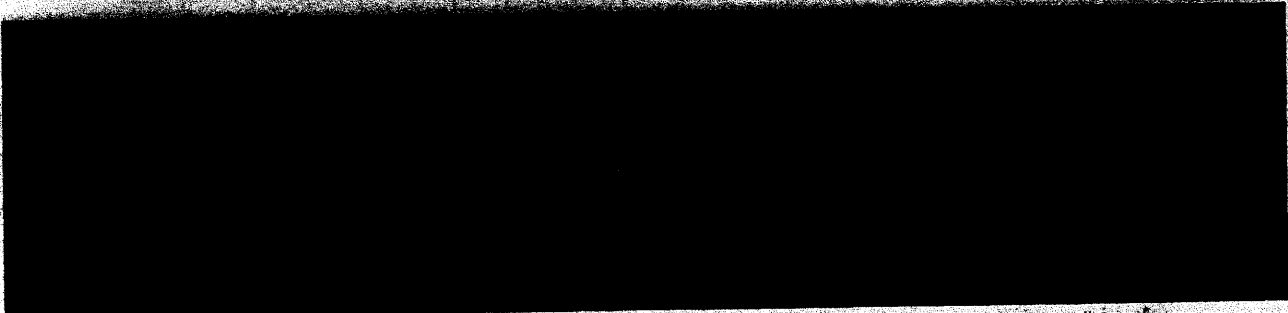

Dear Mr. and Mrs. McGarth:

Thank you for your recent letter to President Bush, expressing support for the operation of the Straight, Inc. treatment facility in Springfield, Virginia. Your letter has been forwarded for reply to the Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Mental Health Administration (ADAMHA). We are sorry for the delay in responding.

ADAMHA is the agency responsible for Federal funding of substance abuse treatment services through the Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Mental Health Services (ADMS) Block Grant. The block grant mechanism was established, beginning in 1981, to allow States maximum authority and flexibility in deciding what services are to be funded at the community level. The Straight, Inc. program mentioned in your letter is supported by local donations and fees, and is not funded from the Federal ADMS Block Grant. In addition, any issues related to the establishment, operation, and licensure of drug treatment facilities is strictly a matter of State discretion.

ADAMHA, and its parent agency, the Department of Health and Human Services, take great pride in its long and continuing commitment to attacking the problems of drug abuse in our society, and, with the support of Congress, will provide more significant funding levels for these efforts in the future. Federal, State and local funding supports thousands of community-based substance abuse treatment facilities throughout the Nation, each providing the best services and programs of which they are capable. Neither this agency, nor the President, is in a position to influence the funding of a specific entity.

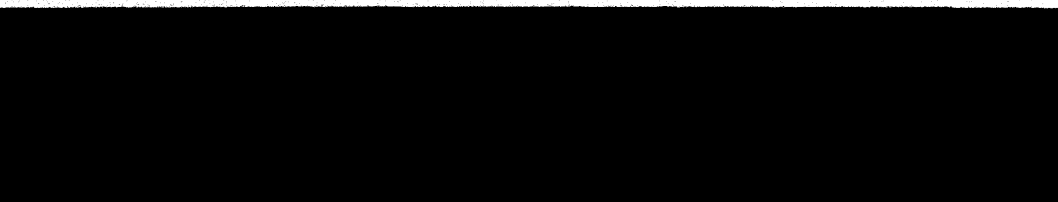

Financially, partly due to the recession, Straight is in serious
trouble. Our debt for the Springfield facility is \$1.25 million;
\$4.5 million nationwide. We could be shut down at any time for
financial reasons.

Politically, we are being subjected to yellow journalism at its
worst. This began when we secured a lease on a building in the
Mount Vernon District, State of Virginia. It seems that the
representative there would prefer to have Straight shut down, and
the kids in treatment back on the streets, rather than have an
adolescent drug treatment center in the Mount Vernon District. How
much better it would be if he would help Straight and other
treatment facilities get the adolescent addicts off the streets and
in to treatment, where they would have a chance at turning their
lives around.

We have pictures of your visit to our Florida facility in our
lobby. Your words of support are on our Straight video. We know
that you and Barbara care. Please help us to keep Straight open
and to continue to provide hope for the thousands of families with
children who are chemically addicted.
