

BOCA MAN GIVES ANTI-DRUG GROUP BUILDING

Growing Together Inc., a non-profit organization that helps young people stay off drugs, received a new building Wednesday.

Dominick Iacovone of Boca Raton has agreed to give his 20,000-square-foot building at Lake Avenue and H Street to the agency, said Jo Ann Endorf, spokeswoman for Growing Together. The building, which together with the land is valued at more than \$200,000, was signed over to the agency Wednesday afternoon, she said. Endorf said the donation was in memory of Iacovone's daughter, Marian Siefert.

Agency officials expect to move from their offices at 1013 Lucerne Ave. in early 1994 and will need donations to set up the new facility.
