Gunter Is Tied To Orlando Interests, **Newton** Charges

Miller Newton, Democratic candidate for the new 5th Congressional District seat, charged Saturday that his opponent, State Sen. Bill Gunter, is "tied to special interests" in downtown Orlando, which is outside the district.

Speaking to the Lake County Democratic Women's Club in Tavares, Newton said representation is a basic issue in the race, since District 5 is made up primarily of small

cities, towns and unincorporated communities, stretching from northern Clearwater to suburban Orlando.

Newton contended that Gunter said in a newsletter that he would represent in Congress "not only the counties in District 5 but also his current constituents in the rest of Orange County," outside the district.

Said **Newton**, "I am committed, as a resident of a

smaller county, to represent all of District 5 in Congress, whereas my opponent from suburban Orlando is tied to special interest outside the district."

Newton said the federal government has aided big cities but discriminated against smaller communities in such programs as grants for sewage treatment. "It is time to see that smaller towns and communities get fair

treatment," he said.
