Members of the newly created Consumer Affairs and Appeal Board for Pasco County were sworn in Monday by Circuit Clerk Miller Newton (back to camera) in New Port Richey. Members of the board are, from left, Henry C. Douglas Jr., Sylvia Young, Royden Pressley, Eddie Herrmann, and Carl Zisman. John Garcia and Dr. William Young, two other board members, were not present when the photograph was taken. The board does not have an enforcement agency, and may not for several weeks. The County Commission will first have to establish a division or office of consumer affairs with a director and staff. The creation of the board stems from a special act of the 1974 Legislature that was introduced by State Rep. Ronald Richmond, R-New Port Richey.
